

### UPPER SCHOOL – POSITIVE REWARD SYSTEM

1. Up to 3 reward tickets can be given to pupils who perform well in class. This can relate to both work and behaviour. It will be left to the teachers discretion as to how they give the tickets.
2. Pupils must write their name on back of ticket at time of issue.
3. Pupils are to put their tickets in a box in their Tutor room. Before or after the draw the number of reward tickets from each pupil must be recorded and saved on the Reward Ticket Record Card, in the 'Shared Documents' area. Mrs Russell will collate weekly.
4. These tickets will be the 'passport' to both individual and class prizes
5. Individual prizes consist of :
  - a) Every 200 tickets collected = a personal non-uniform day and £2 saved towards a voucher of their choice at the end of the year
  - b) An end of term raffle will be held where prizes can be won. Each term the main prize will be of some value eg MP3 player. **SO THE MORE TICKETS IN THE BOX THE GREATER THE CHANCE OF WINNING A PRIZE!**
6. The class prize will be an end of term outing for the class that collectively gains the greatest number of tickets. The pupil with the most tickets from each of the other classes will join them on that trip.
7. Success will be shared each week in Assembly when the 'Class of the Week' will receive a cup ( to be kept for the week) and the 'Pupil of the Week' will be presented with a certificate for their Progress File
8. TUTORS MUST ENSURE THAT AN ACCURATE RECORD OF THE TICKETS ARE KEPT
9. In the event of a pupil behaving irresponsibly eg lesson disruption, bullying, lack of homework etc The tutors reserve the right to :
  - a) reduce their score of tickets by 5 or 10 depending on the offence
  - b) prevent a pupil becoming 'Pupil of the Week'
  - c) stop a pupil going on a 'reward related trip'
