Alliance	An agreement between two or more people, groups or countries to support each other
Armistice	An agreement by countries at war to stop fighting each other.
Assassinated	The act of murdering someone. (Usually an important person)
Invade	To enter an area and forcibly take control
Rationed	Being given a food allowance when food is in short supply
Trench	A long, narrow ditch
Artillery	Large weapons which fire ammunition and are not usually carried by soldiers.
Propaganda	Information, especially of a biased or misleading nature, used to promote a political point of view.








