

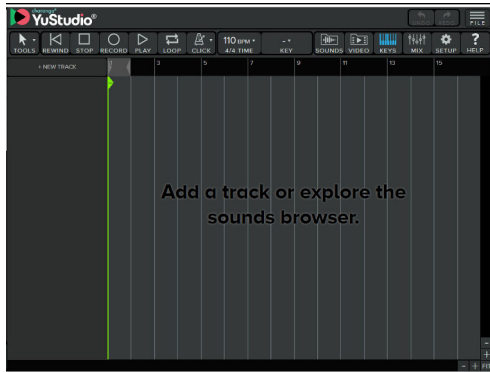

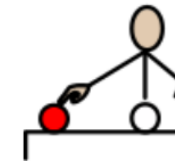

Key Vocabulary



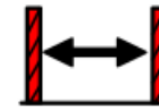
Grime -

A genre of electronic dance music (EDM) that emerged in London in the early 2000s.



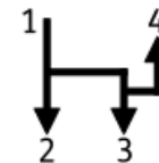
Synthesizer -

An electronic musical instrument that generates audio signals.



Octave -

The distance between two musical notes that have the same letter name



Structure -

The shape of a piece of music; how it is put together



Bar -

A segment of time in music, which is divided into a specific number of beats.
