

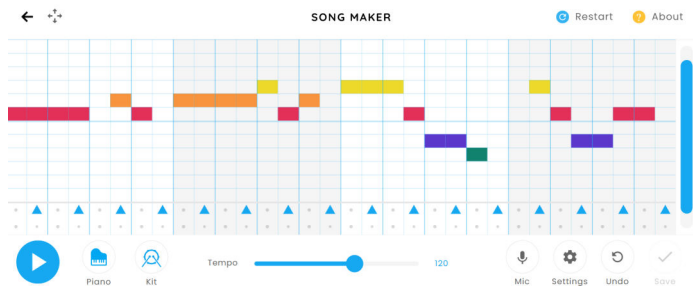

### Key Vocabulary



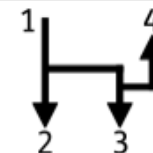
DAW - Digital Audio Workstation, music-making process creating beats and melodies with virtual instruments



Tempo -  
The speed or pace of music  
(fast/slow)



Octave -  
The distance between two  
musical notes that have the  
same letter name



Structure -  
The shape of a piece of music;  
how it is put together



Bar -  
A segment of time in music,  
which is divided into a specific  
number of beats.
