 They will also learn the need to recycle legally for the environment.



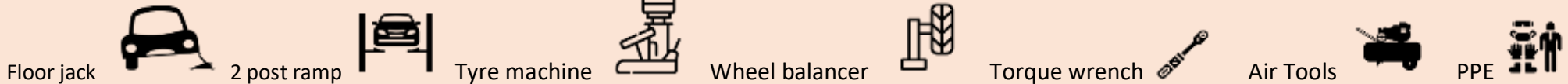
Essential skills to Consolidate.
