

Level 1 Award/ Certificate in Motor Vehicle Studies

This qualification is run through the ABC Awards. The ABC Level 1 syllabus in Motor Vehicle Studies is an approved Vocationally Related Qualification (VRQ).

The structure of this qualification has been designed to give pupils a balance between practical workshop experience and underpinning knowledge of motor vehicle studies. Pupils are assessed through a series of practical competency tests and portfolio work. This qualification provides a useful platform for further study at a higher level after Key Stage 4.



This qualification consist of 5 units which will be studied over 2 years

Unit 01: Introduction to Health and Safety in Motor Vehicle:	In this mandatory unit pupils will explore the responsibility of the employer and employee and the requirements of basic health and safety legislation. They will identify workshop hazards and basic safety procedures	1	4
Unit 15: Wheels & Tyres	In this unit pupils will learn how to identify modern types of road wheels and tyres, their construction and correct usage including the carrying out of practical activities regarding wheels and tyres	1	2
Unit 16: Exhaust Systems	In this unit pupils will learn about modern vehicle exhaust systems their construction and correct usage including the carrying out of practical activities regarding inspection and replacement	1	2
Unit 14: Customer Care	In this unit pupils will learn about the importance in this field of customer relations and the adoption of correct workplace procedures in dealing with customers	1	1
Unit 18: Valeting	In this unit pupils will find out about the selection and application of correct materials when valeting the exterior, interior and engine bay of motor vehicles. They will learn about the correct handling and disposal of waste	1	4
