What is special about my local area?

In Geography this term we will learn about Torquay. We will move on to look at the physical geography around Torquay, thinking about why it may be special. We will then apply this thinking to the human geography around us too, going on field trips to collect data to compare and sort. We will finish by presenting our findings and creating our own special maps to assess what we have learnt.

How has my local area changed since Victorian times?

In History, we will look at lots of photographs of Torquay in the 1800s and compare them to what we know about Torquay now. We will visit Torquay Museum to find out about the first holidays in Torquay, finding out about steam trains and bathing huts and how holidays have changed over time.

Who was Isambard Kingdom Brunel?

In Geography, we will learn about how Isambard Kingdom Brunel changed the landscape of our local area. We will visit important landmarks, including the Tamar Bridge. Closer to school, we will also visit Brunel Manor, the house Brunel started to build before he died at the age of 53.

In History, we will find out about what life was like during Brunel's lifetime. We will research the Industrial Revolution and some of its wonderful designs and constructions, including bridges and railways.
