Thank you once again for your ongoing support.

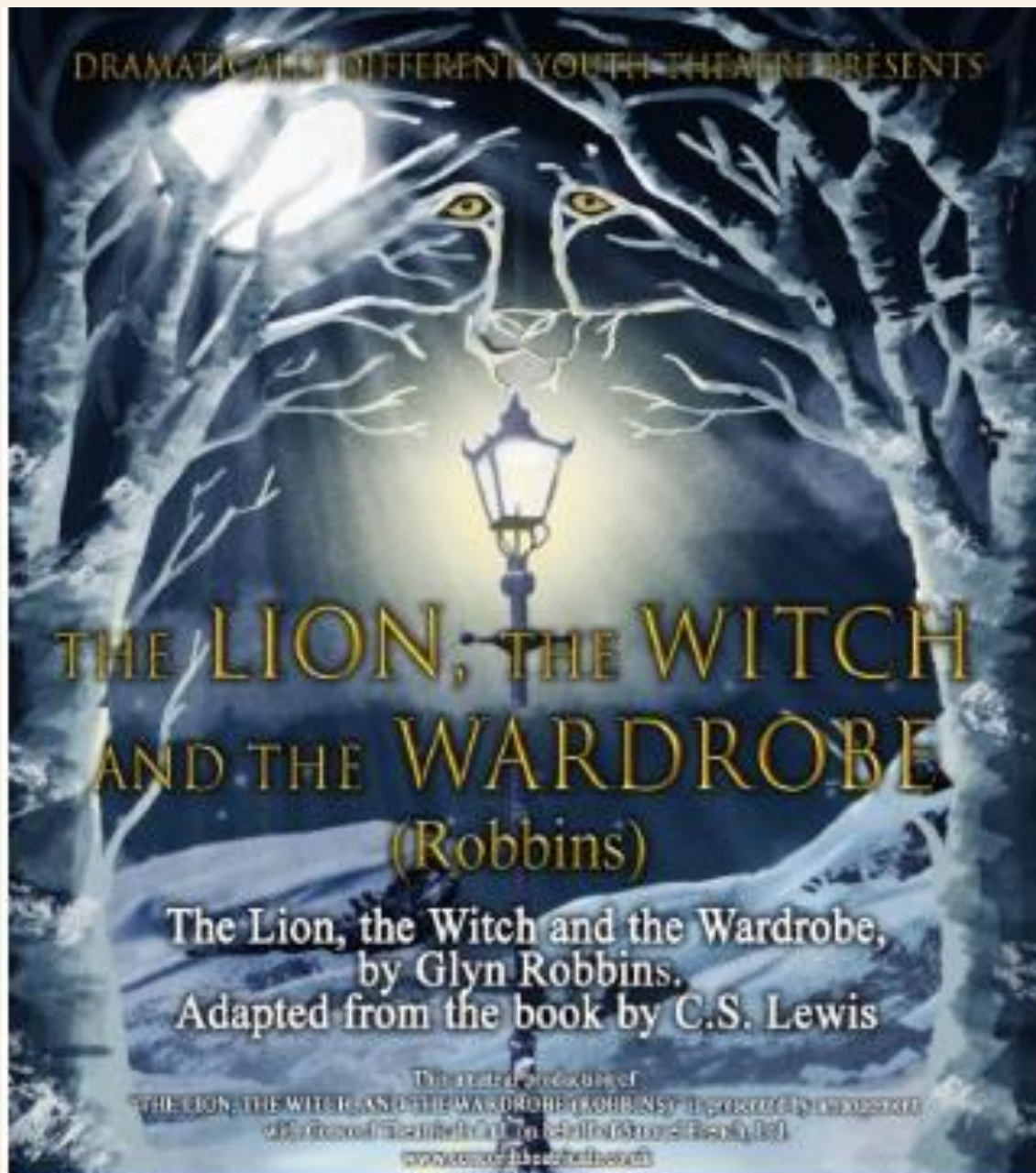

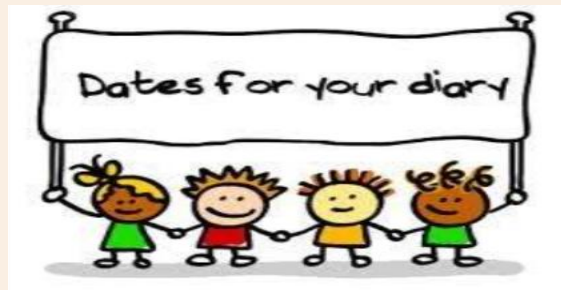
